MINIMUM VIABLE PRODUCT (MVP)

Competitive grants of up to \$25K for pre-revenue startups to progress from proof of concept to MVP stage.

BUILDING PARTNERSHIPS GRANTS

Competitive grant of up to \$100K for startups that are generating revenue to help scale up your business.

R&D TAX INCENTIVE

Provides a Tax offset for some of the company costs of doing eligible R&D activities by reducing a company's income tax liability. You might get up to 43.5% of your development costs.

EXPORT MARKET DEVELOPMENT GRANT (EMDG)

The scheme encourages Australian businesses to engage in international marketing and promotion expenditure to achieve international sales. It reimburses up to 50% of eligible export promotion expenses above \$5K.

TECHVOUCHERS

Grants of up to \$15K, offered by the Department of Industry for NSW companies to connect with experts in relevant fields and work on joint research projects.

CSIRO KICK START

Is a dollar matching initiative of between \$10K and \$50K for small businesses and early stage startups to undertake research with CSIRO to develop a novel product of process.

Provides access to expert guidance and matched project funding to help SMEs commercialise products, processes and services.
